The NDIS Quality and Safeguards Commission (the NDIS Commission) is a new part of the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS).



Quality is about receiving good services.



Safeguards are ways of keeping people safe when they are receiving services.

The NDIS Commission:



- will improve the quality of services



- expects NDIS providers to keep NDIS participants safe.



NDIS participants are people with disability who take part in the NDIS.

The NDIS Commission will start when the NDIS is fully running in each state and territory, from:



- 1 July 2018 – NSW and SA



- 1 July 2019 – ACT, NT, QLD, TAS and VIC



- 1 July 2020 – WA.



Until then, the government in your state or territory will look after the quality and safety of the services you receive.
